## Match background

---

Porto will be hoping to fare better than in their last two home UEFA Champions League matches against Liverpool as the Group B rivals meet again at the Estádio do Dragão on Matchday 2.

- Porto have never beaten Liverpool in eight previous attempts (D3 L5) and conceded nine goals in losing each of their last two home games against their English rivals.
- Liverpool also hold the early advantage in the section having beaten AC Milan 3-2 at Anfield on Matchday 1, when Porto earned a goalless draw at Atlético de Madrid.
- This is Porto's 200th match in the UEFA Champions League, group stage to final. They are just the sixth club to reach that landmark.

### Previous meetings

- Liverpool's victory in the 2018/19 UEFA Champions League featured an emphatic quarter-final win against Porto; Naby Keïta (5) and Roberto Firmino (26) got the goals in the first leg at Anfield before a 4-1 away success at the Dragão. Sadio Mané (26) and Mohamed Salah (65) increased the aggregate advantage before late goals from Firmino (77) and Virgil van Dijk (84) after Éder Militão (69) had pulled one back for Porto.
- In 2017/18, a Mané hat-trick at the Dragão helped Liverpool to a 5-0 first-leg victory in the round of 16, Salah and Firmino also finding the net. The second leg at Anfield finished goalless.
- Then as now, Sérgio Conceição and Jürgen Klopp were the respective coaches of Porto and Liverpool for the above two ties.
- All eight of the matches between the teams have come in the 21st century. Their first came in the quarter-finals of Liverpool's victorious 2000/01 UEFA Cup campaign; Gérard Houllier's side drew the first leg 0-0 in Portugal before first-half goals from Danny Murphy and Michael Owen secured a 2-0 second-leg, and aggregate, victory at Anfield.
- The other matches came in the 2007/08 UEFA Champions League group stage. Dirk Kuyt's 17th-minute goal earned Liverpool a 1-1 Matchday 1 draw at Jesualdo Ferreira's Porto, who had gone in front through Lucho González's eighth-minute penalty. The visitors played the majority of the second half with ten men following Jermaine Pennant's 58th-minute red card.
- At Anfield, Lisandro (33) cancelled out Fernando Torres' 19th-minute opener for Rafael Benítez's Liverpool, before late goals from Torres again (78), Steven Gerrard (84pen) and Peter Crouch (87) gave the home team the points. Porto and Liverpool both went through to the last 16, the Portuguese side winning the section; Liverpool went on to reach the semi-finals.

### Form guide

#### Porto

- This is Porto's 25th UEFA Champions League group campaign, fewer only than Real Madrid and Barcelona (both 26).
- The Portuguese side have qualified for the last 16 on each of their last four appearances in the group stage.
- In 2020/21, Porto finished second in Group C behind Manchester City and ahead of Olympiacos and Marseille. They lost their first game, 3-1 in Manchester, but then remained unbeaten and kept clean sheets in each of the next five (W4 D1).
- In the round of 16, Porto were 2-1 winners at home to Juventus in the first leg, going through on away goals after a 3-2 extra-time defeat in Turin with Sérgio Oliveira's 115th-minute free-kick – his second goal of the game – proving decisive.
- Both legs of the quarter-final against Chelsea were played in Seville, the English club winning the first leg 2-0 and going through despite a 1-0 second-leg defeat.
- Porto finished second in the 2020/21 Portuguese Liga, five points behind champions Sporting CP.
- Porto have lost six of their last 15 matches in the UEFA Champions League proper (W7 D2) but have won seven of their last eight home games in the competition's group stage, drawing the other.
- Porto have lost five of their last eight fixtures against English opponents, last season's 1-0 win against Chelsea in the quarter-final second leg ending a seven-game run without a victory against Premier League clubs.
- Their overall home record against English clubs is W8 D7 L5; all five defeats have come in their last nine matches.

#### Liverpool

- Liverpool are in the UEFA Champions League group stage for the 14th time; they have only failed to progress to the last 16 or further three times.

- This is Liverpool's fifth successive group campaign, all under Klopp; runners-up to Real Madrid in the 2017/18 final, they claimed their sixth European Cup at the expense of Tottenham with a 2-0 victory in the 2018/19 final.
- Liverpool's last two UEFA Champions League campaigns have ended in defeat against clubs from Madrid. Dethroned by Atlético in the 2019/20 round of 16 (0-1 a, 2-3 h aet), they lost to Real Madrid in last season's quarter-finals (1-3 a, 0-0 h).
- Klopp's side had finished first in Group D on 13 points, ahead of Atalanta, Ajax and Midtjylland, before beating Leipzig 2-0 in both legs of their round of 16 tie with both games played in Budapest.
- Champions of England for the 19th time in 2019/20, their first league title since 1990, Liverpool finished third in the 2020/21 Premier League.
- Liverpool have won six of their last nine UEFA Champions League matches away from Anfield (D1 L2).
- The Reds have the record W4 D3 L4 in Portugal; they won on their first two and last two visits but their 2018 victory at Porto was their first in eight trips.

### Links and trivia

- Diogo Jota spent 2016/17 on loan at Porto from Atlético, scoring nine goals in 37 games in all competitions. Iván Marcano, Sérgio Oliveira, Otávio and Jesús Corona were among his team-mates.
- Jota scored past current Porto goalkeeper Cláudio Ramos in a 4-0 success at home to Tondela on 17 February 2017.
- Jota also played for Paços de Ferreira between 2013 and 2016. He made two Liga appearances against Porto, in a 2-1 defeat at the Dragão on 5 December 2015 and a 1-0 home win on 10 April 2016 in which he scored the only goal.

- Pepe briefly crossed paths with Fabinho at Real Madrid in 2012/13, the latter making only one senior appearance in what proved his sole campaign with the club.
- During the summer Grujić sealed a permanent transfer to Porto after a season-long loan from Liverpool, the club he joined in 2015. He made eight Premier League appearances for the Reds, all as a substitute.
- Toni Martínez and Adrián were West Ham team-mates between 2016 and 2018, the Spanish striker mostly featuring in the club's Under-21 and Under-23 teams while his compatriot was involved with the senior squad.

#### Porto

##### • Summer transfers

- Jesús Corona's next appearance in UEFA club competition will be his 50th.
- Porto are still unbeaten in this season's Portuguese Liga (W5 D2), scoring 16 goals and conceding only four in their seven matches. Goals from Mehdi Taremi and, in the 89th minute, substitute Sérgio Oliveira secured a 2-1 victory at Gil Vicente on Friday.
- Oliveira scored 13 league goals in 2021/22; his free-kick winner at the weekend was his first of the current campaign, on his fourth appearance.
- Luis Díaz and Taremi both scored twice in a 5-0 win at home to Moreirense on 19 September.
- Taremi's first goal against Moreirense was his 11th successful penalty in the Portuguese Liga. He is yet to miss from the spot having scored seven for Rio Ave and four for Porto.
- Díaz is now the Portuguese Liga's leading scorer this season with five goals.
- Summer signing Pepê scored his first goal for Porto against Moreirense.



- Goalkeeper Agustín Marchesín had surgery on his right knee on 19 August and is yet to return to action.
- Pepe was substituted against Atlético on Matchday 1 and has not played since due to an injury to his left leg.
- Pepe became the oldest player to play an official match for Porto in the first round of this season's Portuguese Liga. The Dragons' captain was aged 38 years 163 days when they beat Belenenses on 8 August, eclipsing the record of former goalkeeper Silvino.
- The win against Gil Vicente was Sérgio Conceição's 35th successive Portuguese Liga match without defeat, the third longest run for a Porto coach behind Bobby Robson (53 matches) and Vítor Pereira (43).

- Alisson Becker's next appearance in UEFA club competition will be his 50th.
- Liverpool are unbeaten in 17 games in all competitions (W12 D5), stretching back to the 3-1 loss at Real Madrid in last season's UEFA Champions League quarter-final first leg.
- The Reds had won four successive games in all competitions, scoring three goals in each of them, before being held at Brentford on Saturday – although they again found the net three times in a 3-3 draw.
- Sadio Mané struck his 100th goal for Liverpool in a 3-0 defeat of Crystal Palace at Anfield on 18th September, his tenth goal against the Eagles for the Reds.
- Mohamed Salah's goal at Norwich on 14 August made him the first player ever to score in the opening Premier League game five seasons in a row.
- Salah scored his 100th Premier League goal for Liverpool at Brentford, his 151st appearance in the competition for the Reds; no player has reached the century quicker in the club's history.
- Divock Origi was on target in a 3-0 win at Norwich in the English League Cup third round on 21 September, his first goal for Liverpool in 19 games.
- Takumi Minamino got Liverpool's other two goals; all six of his strikes for the club have come away from Anfield.
- Curtis Jones made his 50th Liverpool appearance against Norwich. He scored his first goal of the season in the weekend draw at Brentford.
- Liverpool will visit second-tier Preston in the League Cup last 16 in the week beginning 25 October.
- Roberto Firmino suffered a hamstring injury in a 1-1 home draw with Chelsea on 28 August, returning as a second-half substitute on Saturday.
- Trent Alexander-Arnold played 90 minutes at the weekend having been out since Matchday 1 due to illness.
- Thiago Alcántara has been out since picking up a calf injury against Palace while Naby Keïta had to be substituted in the League Cup win at Norwich with an ankle problem and missed the weekend draw.
- Harvey Elliott is facing a lengthy lay-off after suffering a dislocated ankle in a 3-1 win at Leeds on 12 September.
- Alisson, Alexander-Arnold, Jordan Henderson, Andy Robertson, Virgil van Dijk, Fabinho and Nathaniel Phillips all signed new long-term Liverpool contracts over the summer.
